We are so glad you can join us today for our annual Auction! This day will be full of lots of fun, food, & fellowship. The Parish Auction is a tradition for us. You will find we have everything from farm items to homemade baked goods to home décor and gift certificates. This is the largest fundraiser of the year for St. Patrick's, and by extension, St. Mary's Schools. In the last several years, we have raised anywhere from \$120,000 to \$140,000 to help offset expenses for the church and schools.
